

A New Guitar.

Musicians in general will be interested in the new ten-string guitar recently invented by Mr. Carl Brown, of this city, and manufactured by the New Orleans branch of the Columbus Harpochord Co. The instrument is said to contain the best tones of any yet heard. The New Orleans house is sending them out by the hundreds, and the sales are enormous. The company here is located on West Broad street, at the west end of the bridge, and the large number of employes are working overtime to keep up with orders on the celebrated harpochord turned out by this firm, which is also the invention of Mr. Brown. The manufacture of the guitar will be commenced by the local concern for this market at an early date, or as soon as the orders have been caught up with.
