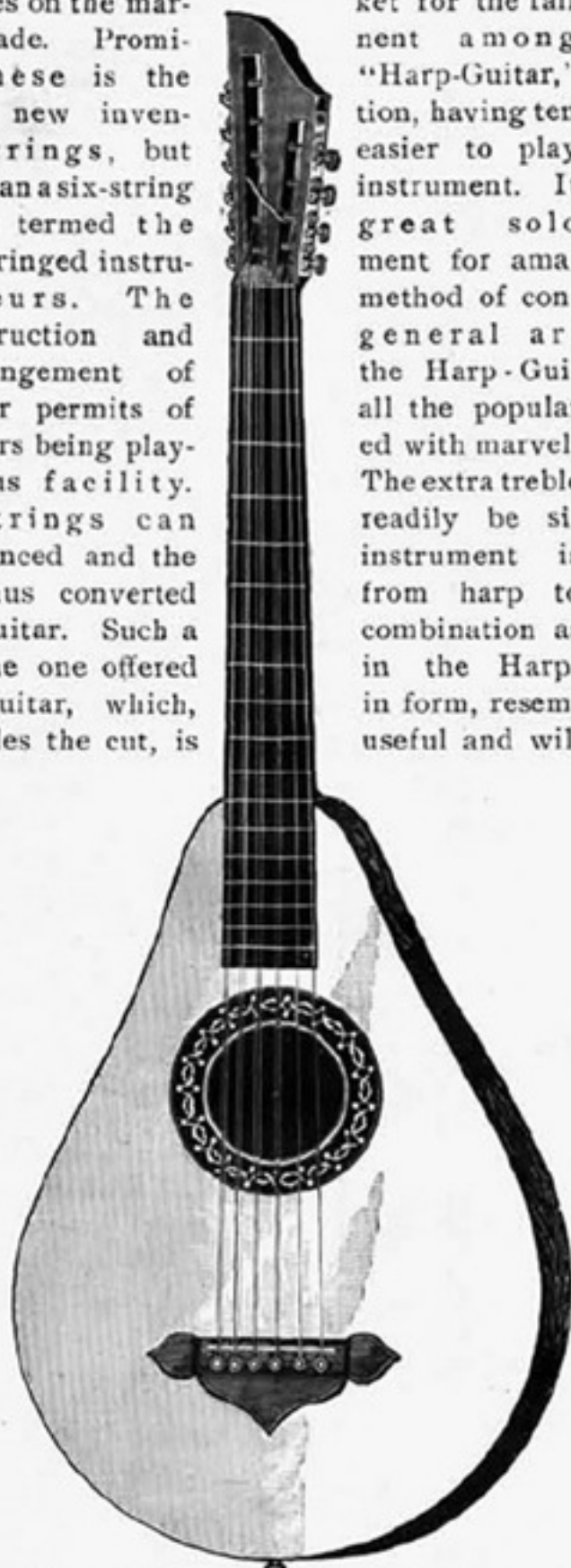


The Gordon Harp-Guitar.

Prominent among these is the "Harp-Guitar," a new invention, having ten strings, but easier to play than a six-string instrument.
