A capacity house at the Royal Theatre last evening marked the debut of the famous Genoa Guitarist, Pasquale Taraffo. Preceded by great fame, he was awaited with much expectation by our public and we were not disappointed. Taraffo made his entrance on the stage and took his position behind his huge Guitar, which is supported by a stand and has fourteen strings instead of the usual six, an instrument of his own creation eight free bass strings having been added by him, a species of Appendix enlarging the so-called harmonical case from normal.

The crowd which filled the house, and which usually is noisy and inclined to ridicule a new artist, lapsed into profound silence as he started to tune his instrument. From the first note he conquered the souls of the audience, the faultless interpretation of this great Guitarist held the attention of the audience who gave a demonstration as only an audience can when confronted with a marvelous surprise of an exceptional artist of extraordinary ability.
